Key West Departure Information:

Pre-Rally Captains Meeting:

We ask that each captain attend the informational meeting on Nov 13th. Time and location in Key West to be advised. It will be conducted by Lead Captain: Steven Sharkey

You will be responsible for your own docking slip, fees, accommodations and all expenses while you are in Key West pre and post **KEY WEST- HAVANA RALLY™**.

Each captain will receive a comprehensive information packet prior to the meeting.

Each participant will also receive a comprehensive information packet prior to departure.

Cuban Visa and Medical Insurance are included in your rally fee and will be provided to you as will a copy of your travel affidavit with legal 12-category license. Boat insurance is not included. Please ask your provider.

Medical Assistance: Please note that while you are cruising to and from Havana, there will be no medical professional to accompany or that will be assigned to the rally. Please be advised that your participation is at your own risk. Medical service and assistance while in Cuba is included in your package and only in effect while you are on the mainland.
